NOTICE TO MARINERS No.06 of 2017

Unattended Vessels on Public Quays

Mariners are advised that the Port of Barrow Harbour Byelaws 1985, Section 16 requires vessels not to be left unattended without the permission of the Harbour Master or other person with delegated authority.

Vessels which are permitted to lay unattended on Public Areas of the Port such as Town Quay are advised that appropriate security measures should be in place. Doors and hatches should be locked and deck equipment secured. Best endeavours should be made to make mooring arrangements tamper proof. Vessels should be inspected and checked on a daily basis to ensure the vessel remains secure and will not present a hazard to other users.

Any breaches of security on Public Quays should be reported to the Police and Barrow Port Radio.
