

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Lowestoft – Transit of an Unmanned Surface Vessel

Mariners and Port Users are advised that an unmanned surface vessel (USV) will transit from the Port of Lowestoft on Monday 24th January 2022 and will be used for survey works at Greater Gabbard offshore windfarm detailed on the table below. The USV "X-08" is operated by 'XOcean' (MMSI 232027631) and will be remotely controlled by a USV 'Pilot'. The vessel is capable of working 24/7. The USV has AIS, Navigation lights a radar reflector and has a yellow superstructure (see below photo). The survey work should be completed by Monday 31st January 2022, subject to favourable weather conditions.

The vessels will transit to and from the survey area from the Royal Norfolk and Suffolk Yacht Club in Lowestoft Outer Harbour area. When transiting Harbour areas and approaches the USV's will be escorted by a Wood Marine vessel acting as a Safety Boat. The Safety Boat will be monitoring VHF Ch14 during Harbour transits.
