The port industry in the UK is the second largest in Europe and Associated British Ports (ABP) is the largest port operator in the country, with 21 ports around Britain.

ABP's ports include Immingham, the UK's largest port by tonnage, and Southampton, the nation's second largest container port, as well as the UK's number one port for cars and cruise. Every year, ABP handles around 25% of all UK seaborne trade - more than 85 million tonnes of cargo.

Collectively the ports handle around 1.4 million containers, 1.7 million vehicles and around 3 million cruise and ferry passengers each year. We also own and run Britain's busiest inland rail terminal, Hams

#### Cardiff


One of the nation's major ports and a critical trading hub for businesses in Wales and elsewhere in the UK.


We also have a head office in London and 11 Short Sea Ports located across 4 UK regions.
