TEMPORARY REDUCTION OF MAINTAINED DEPTH

BA CHART 1866

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that further to Local NTM 12/2020, a Hydrographic Survey was carried out at the Port of Ayr on 14th April 2020. The Hydrographic Survey confirmed there is still a reduction in available water at the Port Entrance.

Further Dredging Operations are scheduled to commence on 18th April 2020.

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that until further notice, the calculation to determine a vessel's maximum draught is as follows:

Total Available Water (Ayr & Troon Tide Tables 2020) – 1.40m = Maximum Vessel Draught

A further Hydrographic Survey will be completed on completion of Dredging Operations. A further Local NTM will be issued following completion of this Survey.
