Local Notice to Mariners No 7 / 2011

Lowestoft Port Traffic Lights

There have recently been numerous incidents where small vessels have proceeded against Port traffic signals.

Mariners and Port Users are reminded that vessels are not safe to proceed unless given the appropriate light signal, (green/white/green or green), and given instructions that it is safe to do so by Port Control. This applies for Port Traffic lights at the Pier Heads, Marina entrance, and in the Bridge Channel.

All vessels must maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 14 and report all movements within the Harbour area to Lowestoft Port Control. Should there be a problem contacting Port Control, then contact can be made via Tel. No. 01502 572286

Marinas are particularly requested to make berth users and visitors aware of this notice and these requirements.
