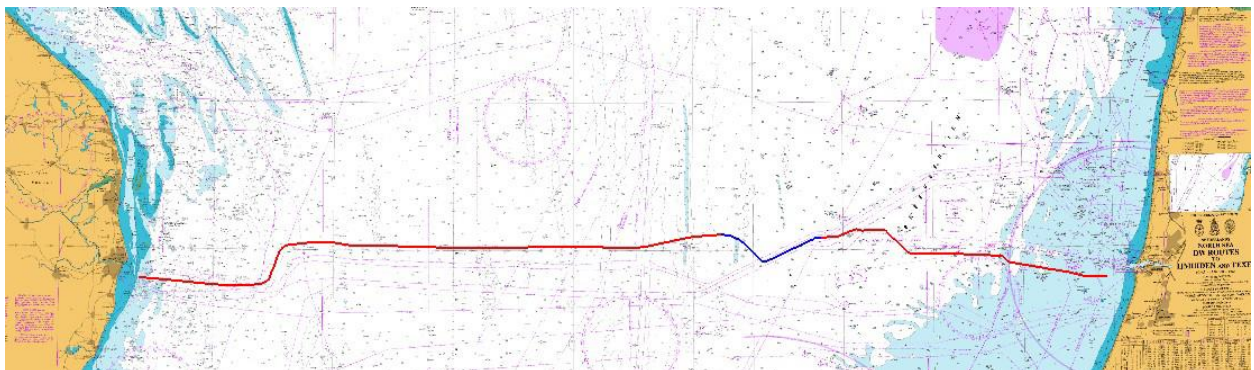
NOTICE TO MARINERS

LOWESTOFT SE APPROACHES – SURVEY OPERATIONS

Mariners and Port Users are advised that survey operations are scheduled to commence between the UK and Netherlands, commencing Friday 13th November. Duration of survey anticipated to be approx. 14 days (subject to weather delays).

The survey operations will be conducted by survey vessel 'Franklin' and will commence from the UK Coast working Eastwards. The vessel will be deploying towed underwater survey equipment at which times will restrict her ability to manoeuvre. At such times the vessel will display relevant lights and shapes as prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.

The below chart extract shows the intended survey route, with initial survey positions listed.



1. 52° 27' 00.4654" N 1° 47' 35.2484" E
2. 52° 26' 52.8904" N 1° 52' 28.5087" E
3. 52° 26' 07.8693" N 1° 59' 42.3601" E

Mariners and Port users are requested to navigate with caution when in vicinity of these survey operations, affording the survey vessel Franklin as wide a berth as is safe and practical to do so.
