# **Description:**

Introduction of new IALA Approved Traffic Light System.

## **Impact on Mariners:**

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that a new IALA approved traffic light system has been introduced at the Port of Troon. The details of the new traffic light system are as follows:

#### Entrance/Exit of the Harbour (West Pier):

- Clear to proceed: 3 all-round lights in a vertical line (Green, White, Green)
- Not clear to proceed: 3 all-round red lights in a vertical line

## Entrance/Exit to the Yacht Marina:

- Clear to proceed: 3 all-round lights in a vertical line (Green, White, Green)
- Not clear to proceed: 3 all-round red lights in a line





#### Entrance to the Fish Dock:

- Not Clear to proceed: Red light
- Clear to proceed: Green light

All vessels in the area are to navigate with extreme caution and comply with the new traffic light signals as well as instructions from Troon Port Control on VHF CH 14 whilst entering and exiting the harbour.

As a reminder, clearance should be sought from Troon Port Control before proceeding inwards or outwards.

#### Additional Information:

The new traffic light system is designed to enhance safety and improve traffic management within the harbour.

Mariners should familiarise themselves with the new light signals and their meanings to ensure safe navigation.

The lights are strategically placed to be visible from a distance, providing clear guidance to vessels approaching the harbour.

Failure to comply with the new IALA traffic light system and or any instructions regarding any vessel movements will invoke the ABP's enforcement policy and could result in prosecution.
