

NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 17 OF 2015

Channel speed restriction

REFERENCE the Port of Barrow Byelaws Part II Section 8 Speed of Vessels, *“Except with the permission of the Harbour Master and, subject to byelaw 7 [Vessels to Navigate with care] and the Collision Regulations, the master of a vessel shall not cause or permit the vessel to proceed at a speed greater than 8 knots”*.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Harbour Master has granted permission for vessels to exceed the 8 knot speed limit in the channel between the following Aids to Navigation when safe to do so:

- Lightning Knoll/Sea 1 and West Scar/East Scar buoys
- Head/Pickle Scar beacons and West Elbow buoy/East Elbow beacon

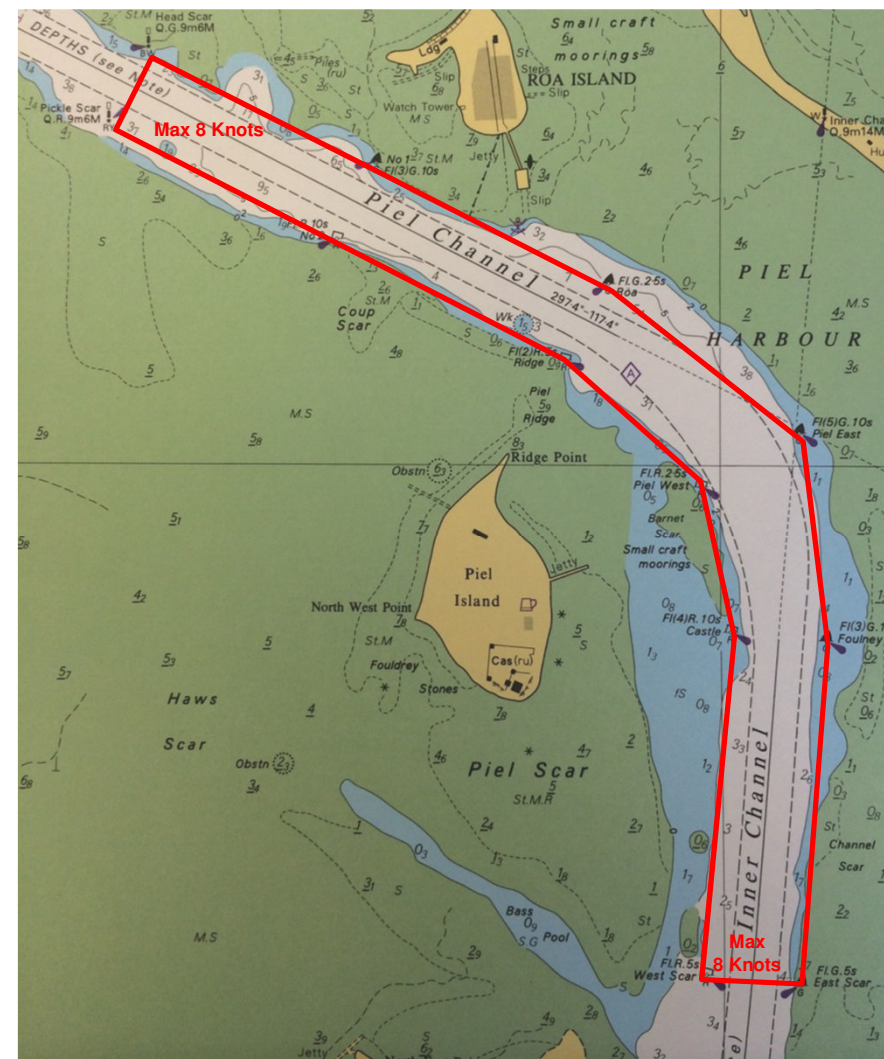

- Full regard shall be had to the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (ColRegs) and the observation of good seamanship.
- Consideration should be given to other water users, with special consideration to small leisure craft, dinghies and kayaks.
