



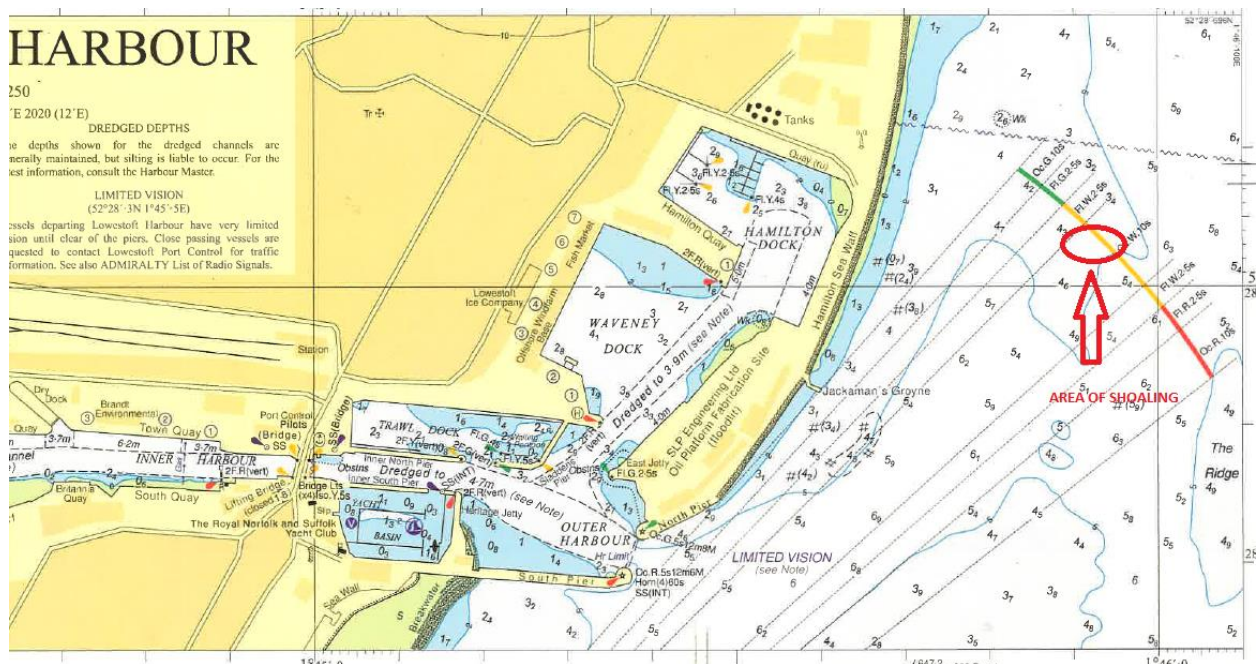

NOTICE TO MARINERS

LOWESTOFT APPROACHES – SHOALING NORTH EAST OF HARBOUR ENTRANCE

Mariners and Port Users are advised of an area of shoaling approx. 700 metres North East of Lowestoft Harbour entrance, approx. position 52° 28.4'N, 001° 45.9'E. Least recorded depth in this area is 3.6m below Admiralty Chart Datum.



The area of shoaling is within the white occulting sector of the Port Entry Light (PEL). This light is an aid to navigation but should not be solely relied upon for an indication of vessel position. Deeper water is available in the Eastern side of the approach channel keeping within the white sectors of the approach PEL.

It is planned to address this shoaling over the current dredging campaign. Depths will then be verified via a post dredge survey. Notice will be provided once depths have been restored.
