NOTICE TO MARINERS

LOWESTOFT - OUTER HARBOUR – BOREHOLE OPERATIONS

Mariners and Port Users are advised that borehole operations are scheduled for the outer harbour.

A jackup barge will be mobilised from North Quay 6 from Monday 24th February 2020.

The tug 'Jumbo' will be used to move the Jack - up to each borehole location.

Two boreholes will be drilled on the north side of Waveney dock adjacent to the Hamilton peninsula (No. 1 and 2).

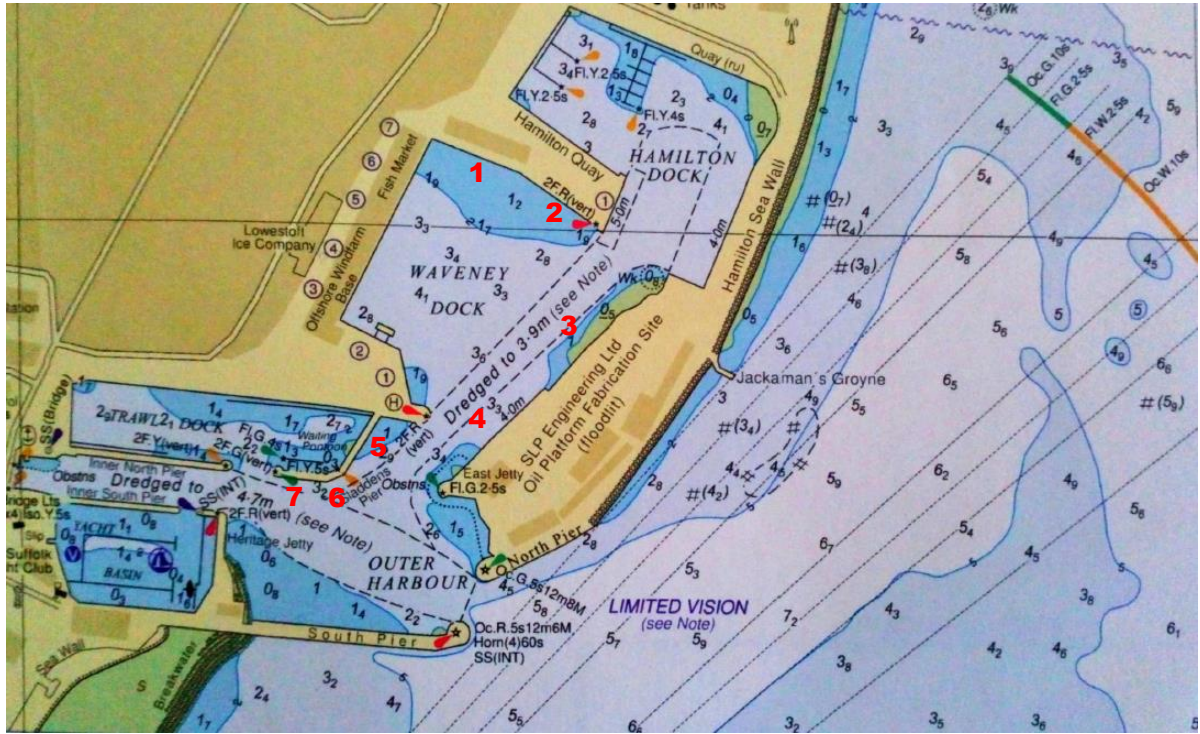
Two boreholes will be drilled along the eastern edge of the navigational channel up to Waveney dock (No. 3 and 4).

Three boreholes will be drilled around the south west arm of the Trawl dock / Sladdens (No. 5, 6 and 7).

The boreholes will be drilled by a jack up barge 'Haven Seajack 2' 18.3 x 18.3 m. One borehole will be drilled at a time and the jack up will start with Borehole No. 1, the other boreholes may not be drilled in a consecutive order.

Borehole Locations

During these borehole operations Channel width will be restricted in these area. Vessels will not be permitted to pass between the closest shoreline and the rig for each borehole location. Passing vessels are requested to give the jack up a wide berth.

Borehole No. 6 and No. 7 may cause some disruption on large vessel movements.

Updates on the movement of the jackup can be obtained through Lowestoft Port Control.
