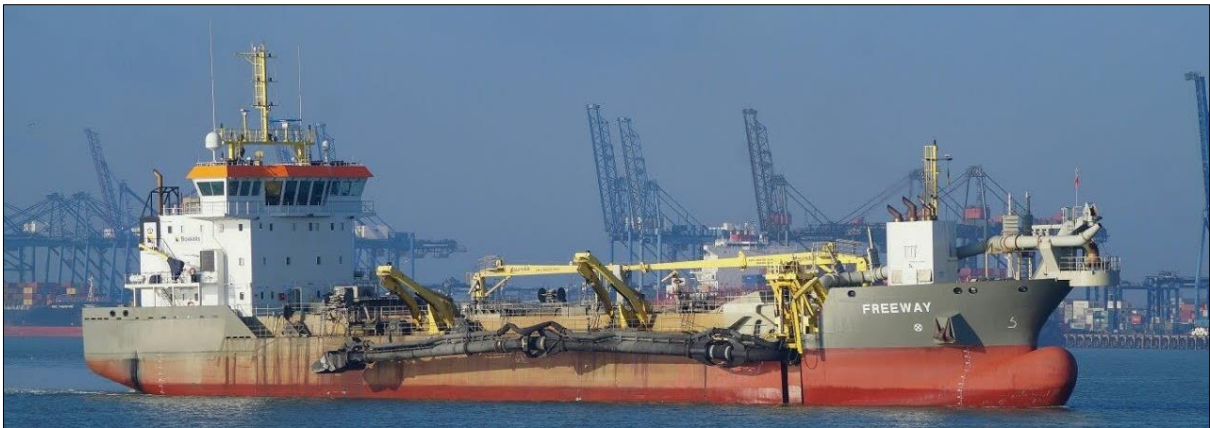


PORT OF BARROW

NOTICE TO MARINERS No.04 of 2020 BARROW CHANNELS MAINTENANCE DREDGE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Saturday 11th January 2020 and until further notice, the trailer suction hopper dredger, 'FREEWAY' will commence dredging the Barrow approach channels between Lightning Knoll and Ramsden Dock Entrance.



Dredging will be almost continuous. Mariners should expect to encounter the vessel at any time and at any position between Ramsden Dock Entrance and the disposal area which is approximately 2 miles South of Lightning Knoll Buoy.

The dredger will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea.

The Multicat "Torch" will be in assistance and will be engaged in ploughing the Barrow approach channels between Lightning Knoll and Ramsden Dock Entrance.

Mariners are requested to give the vessel a wide berth when dredging or dumping spoils in the disposal area. The dredger should be given a wide berth when transiting the Barrow approach channels as she may be constrained by her draught.

The vessel will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout the operation. Mariners may also request dredger movement information from "Barrow Port Radio" also on VHF Channel 12.

A further notice will be issued upon completion.
