



GENERAL NOTICE TO FISHERMEN

APPROACH TO SILLOTH MARSHALL DOCK

Fishing vessels wanting to enter Silloth Marshall Dock are recommended to make their approach from a distance of approximately 2 cables from the North knuckle. Initially they should stem the tide to access its effect and once this has been done then approach keeping the north dock entrance open. Once they come into the lee of the break water they should then turn and make their entrance at a suitable speed to effect a safe passage.

Vessels should be aware that they may experience a counter current as they get closer in to the entrance especially on spring tides.
