NOTICE TO MARINERS No.29 of 2024

Barrow Spot Dredge @ Smite Inlets, Walney Channel

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from **Monday 30th September 2024, 09:00am** and until further notice, the hopper dredger, Cherry Sand will commence dredging inner Walney channel near BAE's smite inlets.



Hopper Dredger Cherry Sand's, dredging will be focussed to deepens the BAE's smite inlets and should completed in about 2 weeks.

The survey crafts (**Christine H**) would be surveying the smite inlet area at some points during the project, will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea.

Mariners are requested to give these vessels a wide berth when dredging/surveying or dumping spoils in the disposal area. The dredger should be given a wide berth when transiting the inner walney channels as she may be constrained by her draught.

All vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 12 throughout their operations. Mariners may also request dredger movement and information from "Barrow Port Radio" also on VHF Channel 12.

This notice will be withdrawn upon completion of spot dredging.
