

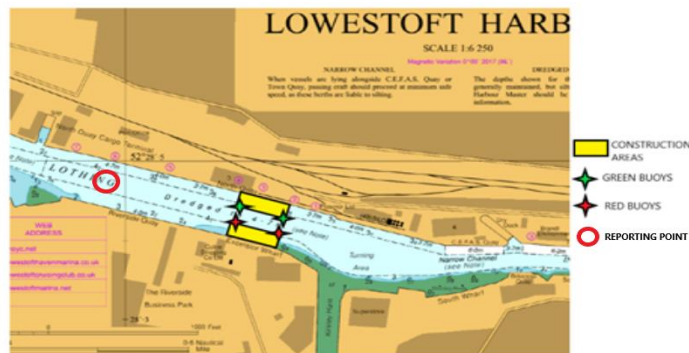
NOTICE TO MARINERS

Lowestoft Inner Harbour – Gull Wing - Marine Construction Activities – Temporary Reporting Requirements

UTC BST

Mariners and Port Users are advised of a temporary additional reporting requirement in relation to the Gull Wing construction activity in Lake Lothing.

With immediate effect, all vessels transiting from the West and intending to pass through the navigational channel between North and South areas of construction at the Gull Wing Construction Site, are requested to make every effort to contact Port Control on VHF Ch 14 when approaching the construction area (from approx. position as indicated by red circle on chart extract below).



It is appreciated that not all small vessels are able to reach port control if using hand held sets when this far off. In such circumstances port control may be contacted by telephone – 01502 572286 (option 3), to advise of intended transits.

This temporary procedure will enable port control to appraise all vessels of other traffic movements when navigating in this area.

The requirement for vessels to report to Port Control when passing Silo berth outwards still remains in force.
