

PORT OF SILLOTH NOTICE TO MARINERS

NO. 04/2015 (revised 11/09/15)

LOCAL PORT SERVICE (LPS)

CHANGE TO INBOUND VHF REPORTING PROCEDURE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT, vessels are instructed to make contact with 'Silloth Harbour Radio' (VHF CH12) as detailed below.

For <u>Inbound</u> passages VHF contact should be made approximately 2 hours prior to high water Silloth, before the vessel passes Maryport, **at position 54° 42.2'N 003° 34.0'W**.

The following information must be provided to the LPS:

- Number of persons on board (including pilot).
- Draft.
- Any defects.
- Request for supply of fresh water.

An additional VHF report should be made to 'Silloth Harbour Radio' when 1.0nm from the 'Solway Buoy'.

For <u>Outbound</u> passages VHF contact must be made prior to letting go. The following information must be provided:

- Number of persons on board (including pilot).
- Draft
- · Any defects.
- Destination.

A final VHF report should then be made to 'Silloth Harbour Radio' on clearing the 'Solway Buoy'.
