

NOTICE TO MARINERS

Lowestoft Harbour – Dredging Activities

UTC BST

Mariners and Port-Users are advised of dredging activities scheduled for Lowestoft as follows: -

- Vessel UKD Cherry Sand – Commencing work tomorrow, 21/03/21. Working hours: 0700-1900hrs daily. Expected duration of works: 20-24 days.
- Vessel UKD ORCA – Provisionally due at Lowestoft on or around 09/04/2021. Normal working hours: 24hr. Expected duration of works: 5 days.
- Vessel UKD Seahorse or Sealion (TBC) – Provisionally due at Lowestoft on or around 18/04/21. Working hours: 0700-1900hrs daily. Expected duration of works: 8 days.

The dredgers will work both Inner and Outer Harbour Areas, also in Lowestoft Approach Channel (UKD Orca and UKD Seahorse/Sealion only). They will display lights and shapes for dredging activities as prescribed in the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.

The vessels will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch 14. Vessel movements will be co-ordinated via Lowestoft Port Control.

Mariners and Port Users are requested to afford the dredgers a wide berth while they are undertaking dredging operations.
